WHAT ARE THE PCE EXAMS?

What Are the UNED Specific Competency Tests (PCE)?

The Specific Competency Tests (PCE) are specialized exams designed for students who have obtained their high school diploma or an equivalent qualification outside of Spain and wish to apply to Spanish universities. These tests serve as the international equivalent of the Spanish “Selectividad” (university entrance exam), and are specifically tailored to assess academic competencies in various subjects.

Their importance lies in providing a standardized pathway for international students to demonstrate their academic preparedness and subject-specific knowledge, thereby complementing their foreign secondary education credentials. The grades obtained in the PCE, together with the student’s high school GPA, form the basis of the final university admission score in Spain.

Who Should Take the PCE?

The PCE exams are primarily intended for students who have completed or are in the process of completing their high school or secondary education outside of Spain, and who wish to pursue higher education at Spanish universities.

For students from non-EU countries or countries without a bilateral agreement for diploma recognition, UNEDasiss generally recommends taking a minimum of 4 PCE subjects in order to meet university admission requirements in Spain.

This complexity highlights the importance of personalized academic guidance, ensuring that students not only meet the minimum requirements, but also strategically select subjects that will maximize their admission score for their desired degree program and university. It’s not just about doing the minimum — it’s about optimizing the outcome.

Taking fewer subjects may seem easier, but it could significantly limit university options or reduce the maximum admission score (e.g., 10 vs. 14 points).

UNED REQUIREMENTS

Planning Your University Admission in Spain

If you want to secure a place at a university in Spain, you'll need to plan ahead. For many degree programs, you'll be required to take Specific Competency Tests (PCE), so it's important to start your preparation as early as possible. You should also keep track of key deadlines and be informed about the legal procedures necessary to study in Spain.

Steps to Begin Your Preparation and Key Recommendations

1. Check the specific admission requirements based on your country of origin.
2. Review the entry requirements of the universities in Spain where you wish to study.
3. We strongly recommend obtaining a B2 level Spanish certificate, through one of the following exams: DELE, SIELE, or ACLES.
4. Prepare the required documents:
 - a. Official recognition (homologación) of your high school diploma and final grades.
 - b. Valid passport, NIE (Foreign Identification Number), or NIF (Fiscal Identification Number).
5. Prepare for the PCE exams (we recommend taking at least 4 subjects).
6. Study hard to achieve the highest possible grades.

How Is the University Admission Score Calculated?

$$\text{UNEDasiss Grade} = 4 + (\text{GPA} \times 0.2) + (\text{S1} \times 0.1) + (\text{S2} \times 0.1) + (\text{S3} \times 0.1) + (\text{S4} \times 0.1)$$

- GPA = Grade Point Average of your high school diploma, either officially recognized (homologado) by the Spanish Ministry of Education or calculated by UNED.
- S1, S2, S3, S4 = Scores obtained in four different PCE subjects.
- Note: Only PCE exams in which you score at least 5 out of 10 are counted toward the final UNEDasiss grade.

Final Admission Score (up to 14 points)

$$\text{Admission Grade} = \text{UNEDasiss Score} + (0.2 \times \text{B1}) + (0.2 \times \text{B2})$$

- B1 and B2 are the two PCE subjects with the highest scores, provided:
 - They have a 0.2 weighting (as defined by the university and degree program you are applying to), and
 - You scored at least 5 in those exams.

This additional weighting can increase your admission score from a maximum of 10 to a maximum of 14 points, which is especially important for competitive degree programs.

ADMISSION SCORE

Example: How the Final University Admission Score Is Calculated

Let's take the case of a student from Algeria who has obtained an officially recognized high school GPA (homologated) in Spain of 7.39.

The student takes 4 PCE subjects and obtains the following results:

1. Physics: 7.05
2. Mathematics: 7.85
3. Chemistry: 6.55
4. Biology: 5.60

Their university admission score would be as follows:

UNEDasiss Score (up to 10 points) = $4 + NMB*0,2 + M1*0,1 + M2*0,1 + M3*0,1 + M4*0,1$

UNED= $(4 + 7.39*0.2) + (7.05*0.1) + (7.85*0.1) + (6.55*0.1) + (5.60*0.1) =$
 $= 5,478 + 0.705 + 0.785 + 0.655 + 0.56 = \underline{\underline{8,156}}$

However, this 8.156 is not the final admission score, as we must add the two highest PCE subject scores multiplied by 0.2, provided that the university assigns them a 0.2 weighting for the chosen degree program.

In this student's case, the two highest scores would be Mathematics and Physics.

For example, if the student wishes to pursue a degree related to Health Sciences (such as Nursing), the calculation would be as follows:

Admission score: $8.156 + \text{Mathematics } 7.85 \times 0.2 + \text{Physics } 7.05 \times 0.2 =$

Final University Admission Score: $8.156 + 1.57 + 1.41 = 11.136$

The student would then be eligible to apply for any degree program with a cutoff score of up to 11.136 points.

! NOT HAVING A B2 CERTIFICATE IN SPANISH MAY PREVENT YOU FROM ACCESSING UNIVERSITY.

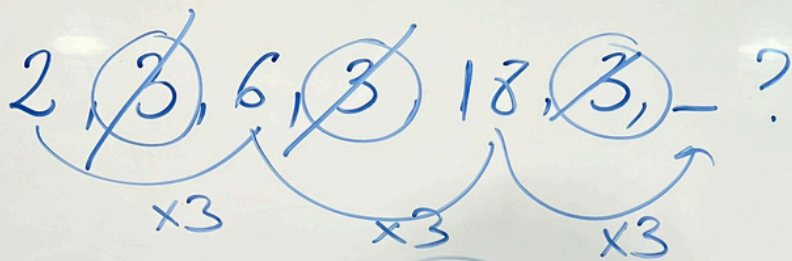
